Subject: Little Waking & Barling Magna sewer relining scheme

Dear Barling Magna Community Primary School,

Many customers within Little Waking and Barling Magna area have suffered from sewer flooding for years. As part of the Anglian Water's commitment to provide better services to customers, we are planning to partially reline the sewers and manholes within Little Waking and Barling Magna, to reduce the infiltration from the ground water to our existing sewers.

The works is planned to start middle February and complete by end of March 2017. The principal contractor over looking the construction is Barhale PLC. Whereas we have a couple of sub contractors representing Anglian Water to carry out the relining work and manhole sealing works on site.

Most of the works will be carried out in Little Waking area however, some works will be carried out near the school, as shown on the attached plan.

Relining work is very low impact technique which normally only requires access to manholes. There will be a few vehicles parked nearby to clean the sewer and install the liner.

As shown on the attached plan, the closest work to school is the one across the field. This work will be carried out during school Feb half term, to reduce the disruption to a minimum. The manhole located on Little Waking Road will require access hence a road closure with diversion will be required to ensure the safety of the general public.

The works at Little Waking Road and Church Road junction will be carried out under 3 way lights.
